



KNPC Mina Al Ahmadi Gas Train 5 Project

Kuwait



B&W Energy Services recently completed work on the Kuwait National Petroleum Company (KNPC) Mina Al Ahmadi Gas Train 5 Project in Kuwait. The US\$1.4 Billion GT-5 project is a segment of the larger plan to increase the gas processing capability of the plant by 800 million standard cubic feet per day (SCFPD) to 3.263 billion SCFPD.

Spanish EPC contractor, Tecnicas Reunidas, contracted B&W to design and execute a full suite of pre-commissioning services at the refinery prior to commissioning and startup. Services include chemical cleaning of four heat recovery steam generators (HRSG), multiple heat exchangers and an oxygen system. Our team also successfully conducted site-wide steam blows, high-velocity lube oil flushing, fuel gas system flushing and AquaLazing of critical compressor suction piping.
