

Talara Refinery



In 2021, B&W Energy Services engineered and executed a large-scale steam blow program at a refinery in Talara, Peru.

The refinery, the second largest in the country based on production, began its modernization project in 2014 with the goal of increasing crude oil processing capacity from 65,000bpd to 95,000bpd and complying with modern clean fuel standards. The project included the addition of several new processing units containing an extensive steam piping network, of which B&W supported cleaning during commissioning. The total investment for the project is estimated to be \$4.7 billion, an unprecedented investment amount for a refinery in Peru.
