



Dos Bocas Refinery Project

Once complete, the Dos Bocas Refinery will be the largest refinery in Mexico, with a capacity of 340,000 barrels of oil per day. It also represents Mexico's first refinery built in the last 40 years. The plant is being developed as part of Mexico's National Refining Plan, which focuses on reducing the need for imported fuel. Construction on the refinery began in 2019 and is predicted to cost over US \$15 billion.
